History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Eugene P. McCornack, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 398, dated July 2, 1881. The original notes state that at the corner a 20" by 14" by 12" marked basalt stone was set 15" in the ground, from which:

A 30" Pine bears S 40° E 49 lks., marked: TlOS R35 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S21 BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 19" in the ground to bedrock and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone.

Note: Marked "AM" on monument set in 1985 above the "CC". Marked 54-3 signs on bearing trees referencing amended monuments "AM".

Utilized existing original bearing trees to reference new monument. Placed an additional 54-3 sign on bearing trees referencing new monument. From the new monument:

A 36" Ponderosa Pine bears N 38° E - 9.0' with scribing visible on partly healed double blazes.

A 28" Ponderosa Pine bears S $30\frac{10}{2}$ E - 29.4° with scribing visible on partly healed double blazes.

Set steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
