Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 2" brass cap on 1" flanged G.I.P. protruding 12" from a mound of stone. Cap is marked as shown on recorded corner certificate. Myers monument bears S 58 36' W - 23.3' from corner position established on this survey. Myers monument was not accepted because of additional original evidence recovered on this survey.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 15" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

A 9" White Fir bears N $85\frac{1}{2}$ ° W - 13.4', scribed: E 1/16 S16 BT.

A 6" Juniper bears S $24\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 58.1', scribed: E 1/16 S21 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary North and South of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 19°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
