Nothing official. A blazed 20" Western Larch bears West 20'.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and a few stones, from which:

A 10" White Fir bears S $66\frac{1}{2}$ ° W - 23.2', scribed: $C\frac{1}{2}$ S21 BT.

A 11" White Fir bears S $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E - 10.0', scribed: $C\frac{1}{4}$ S21 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-9 and 54-3, and painted face of blaze and a 6 red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence post North of corner, and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with $19^{\circ}E$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
