A 11" Western Larch bears N  $13\frac{10}{2}$  E - 32.8', scribed: SW 1/16 S 9 BT.

A 12" Western Larch bears N  $50\frac{1}{8}^{\circ}$  W - 42.3', scribed: SW 1/16 S 9 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary West and North of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
