A 17" Ponderosa Pine bears N $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W - 26.8', scribed: S 1/16 S 8 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary West and East of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.
