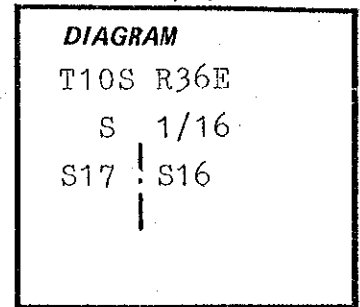


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

None.



No evidence of corner establishment found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½" by 30" aluminum pipe with 2½" aluminum cap, 23" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

A 11" Ponderosa Pine bears N 49½° W-9.5', scribed: S 1/16 S 17 BT.

A 18" Ponderosa Pine bears N 28½° E - 37.0', scribed: S 1/16 S 16 BT.

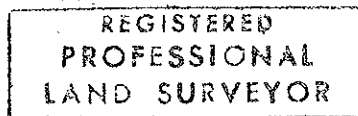
New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary West and North of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and 54-2 to both posts.

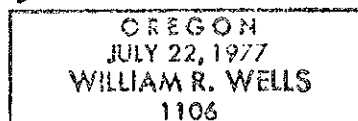
Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on May 9, 1986.
