A 17" Ponderosa Pine bears N 27° W - 63.51, scribed: C & S 8 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6 red band around each bearing tree.

Set a steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with $20^{\circ}\mathrm{E}$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
