A 14" Douglas Fir bears S  $87\frac{10}{8}$  W - 34.9', scribed: E-W-E 1/256 S17 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary West and South of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post, and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.
