## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Herman D. Gradon U. S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 416, dated August 19, 1881. The original notes state that at the corner position a 3' long by 3" square post, set 24" in the ground, marked & S on West face, from which:

T10S R36E 1/4 S9 S10

G-13

A 24" Fir bears N  $50^{\circ}$  E - 21 links, marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT.

A 24" Pine bears N  $50^{\circ}$  W - 55 links, marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT.

No other record of corner remonumentation found in County Record.

## Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner was thoroughly searched for 4 hours with a 2 man crew with 1 PLS. The area has been logged years ago, thinned more recently, and burnt. The remaining stumps are weathered and rotted. Corner search came about 40 years too late! Re-established corner by single proportion measure between the found Northeast corner and Southeast corner of Section 9.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, 25" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears N  $10^{\circ}$  E - 12.6', scribed:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 10 BT.

A 20" Ponderosa Pine bears S  $81\frac{1}{2}$ ° W - 51.2', scribed:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 9 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9, and painted face of blaze and a 6 red band around each bearing tree.

Set steel fence post north of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with  $20^{\circ}\mathrm{E}$  declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on May 9, 1986.
