CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Herman D. Gradon, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 416, dated August 19, 1881. The original notes state that at the corner position a 3' long by 3" square post was set 24" in the ground, marked ½ S on North face, from which:

A 3" Alder bears N 55° E - 32 links, marked: ½ S BT.

A 36" Pine bears South 75° W - 30 links, marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

No other record of corner remonumentation found in County Record.

Description of corner evidence found:

None. Corner area was searched for 3 hours with a 2 man crew, including 3 hours PLS time. The area has been badly disturbed by road construction and logging. Re-established corner by bearing and distance tie from corner 1 of the Medock Quartz Claim MS 225. Corner 1 of the Medock Quartz Claim was re-monumented by Jackson & Prouchnow in 1982. See survey plat. Corner No. 1 of the Medock Quartz Claim bears S 23 14 16 W - 611.00 .

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone, from which:

A 14" Western Larch bears N $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E - 123.2', scribed: $\frac{1}{4}$ S5 BT.

A 16" Douglas Fir bears S $72\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 39.0', scribed: $\frac{1}{4}$ S8 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-9 and 54-3 to each bearing tree, and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

Set a steel fence post East of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on May 12, 1986.
