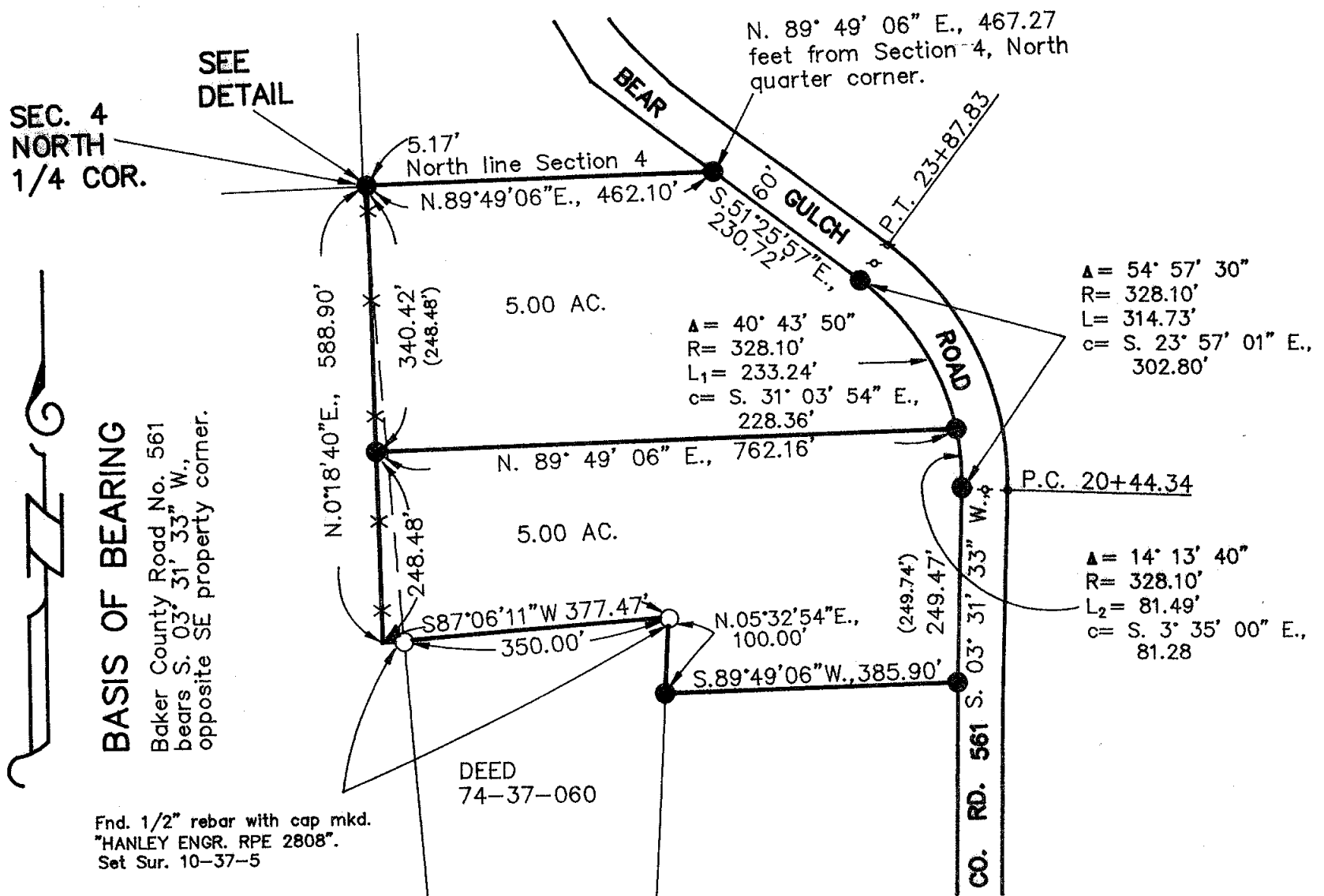


NW¼ NE¼ Sec. 4, T. 10 S., R. 37 E., W.M.



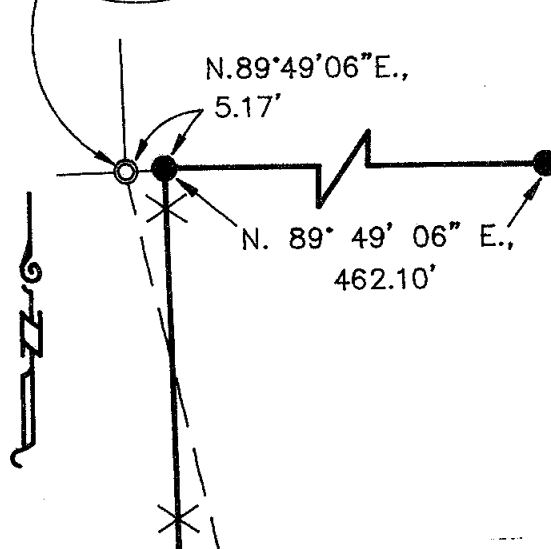
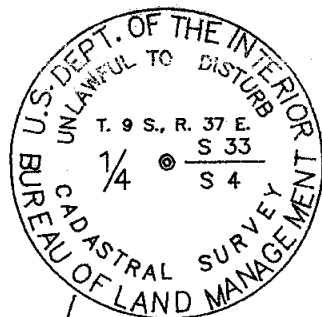

NARRATIVE

The original purpose of this survey for Harold Monroe was to mark on the ground with proper monumentation the corners of two 5 acre tracts of land per his instructions. The original Map of Survey is lost and unrecorded. This Map of Survey was recorded to show the establishment of found property monuments. Said land is located in the NW¼ NE¼ Sec. 4, T. 10 S., R. 37 E., W.M. in Baker County, Oregon. Monumentation described in Baker County Survey No. 10-37-5 was recovered. The West boundary of this parcel is referenced to a boundary line adjustment filed as Baker County Deed 70 21 011, recorded on May 27, 1970.

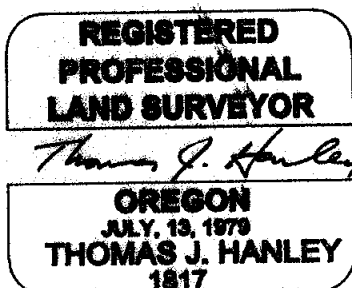


DETAIL
