At the corner I found that the Aluminum cap set by James Hanley had been run over by a cat and destroyed. The pipe was still in the ground. I also found a stone 16" X 8" X 7" with a faint 4 marked on it buried in the hole.

There is nothing remaining of the S35E bearing tree.

The N75W is down and rotted in the proper location with faint scribing.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I replaced the pipe and cap that had been set by James Hanley and had been destroyed with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 32" brass capped steel pipe set 26" in the ground in a mound of stone from which
