CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original survey by Eugene P. McCornack under contract No. 398 dated August 1881.

Set post 3ft long 3ins square 24ins in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor marked $\frac{1}{4}S$ on W face from which;

A pine 48ins in diam bears S 60° E 20 1ks dist marked ${}^{1}_{4}$ S BT

A pine 20ins diam bears S 25°W 23 1ks dist marked 4S BT

In August 1970 Leland Myers monumented the corner from the remaining original evidence. He set a 5/8" X 30" Aluminum capped rebar and no new accessories. Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner location I found no evidence of the original corner post. I did find the aluminum capped rebar set by Leland Myers in 1970. I also found 1 original BT a 22" stump bearing S 25° W marked "S BT" at a distance of 15.2ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I replaced Leland Myers rebar with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "X32" Aluminum capped aluminum pipe set 24" in the ground from which;

An 11" Ponderosa pine bears S 50° 30' E 22.48ft marked 4S30 BT nail in N. base

A 7" Ponderosa pine bears S 58°W 12.82ft marked 4S25 BT nail in E. base

Bearings taken with a staff compass declination $18\frac{1}{2}$ E per 1980 Isogonic chart.

Distances pulled to 60d nails with brass washers stamped LS 1898 set in side center of bearing trees.


