In 1971 the Bureau of Land Managment re-monumented the corners as follows:

The programment corner of sections 5 and 8 monumented with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A Pine stump 30" dia. bears N35°W, 27 lks dist., no marks visible.
A Pine 18" dia. bears S50°W, 54 lks dist., with scribe marks ½ S BT. visible on open blaze,

Set an iron post, 28" long $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. 24" in the ground, with brass cap marked.

From which new bearing trees.

A Fir 11" dia. bears N5°E, 53 lks dist. marked ½ S5 BT. A Ponderosa Pine 10" dia. bears S54½°W, 69 lks dist., marked ½ S8 BT.

Bury basalt stone, 12"x8"x4" with an X chissled on N face, alongside iron post, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base 1½ft. high, N of the corner.
