
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

William R. Gradon, U.S. Deputy Surveyor July 1, 1882

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{12}$ sec cor, marked $\frac{1}{12}$ son west face, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins, N. and S. of post $5\frac{1}{12}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{12}$ ft high, $3\frac{1}{12}$ ft. base around post.



Description of corner evidence found:

Did not find any evidence of this corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

No evidence of original monument found at a proportionate position, set a USES 31/4" aluminum capped monument 20" in the ground, with a mound of stone to cap, from which:

A 5/8" x 18" rebar, bears N.84°17'W., 12.6 ft., with brass washer "RLS 1060".

A 5/8" x 18" rebar, bears N.41°45'E., 32 ft., with brass washer "RLS 1060".

A 5/8" x 18" rebar, bears \$.3°14'E., 37.2 ft., with brass washer "RLS 1060".

A cotton picker spindel set in a N-E fence line corner post, bears N.9°21'W., 1.7'.
