A fir, 12" in diam., bears N.71°E., 31.0 ft., double blazed and scribed," SC1/4S31BT" with nail and brass washer "RLS 1060" in face of BT.

A pine, 12" in diam., bears S.50°W., 16.2 ft., double blazed and scribed," EG+BHBT" with nail and brass washer "RLS 1060" in face of BT.

A pine, 8" in diam., bears N.75°W., 12.8 ft., double blazed and scribed," XBT" with nail and brass washer "RLS 1060" in face of BT.

Placed Forest Service signs (54-2,54-9) on trees and paint scars, blazes and a 6" red band around BT Place a post with Forest Service Sign (54-9) alongside corner.
