I, Kenneth A. Lind, Registered Professional Land Surveyor, hereby certify that I have surveyed Parcel 2 and platted UNSURVEYED Parcel 1 of this partition, situated in Section 20, Township 10 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, being more particularly described as follows:

The Northwest quarter, the Northeast quarter, the Southeast quarter, the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, the North half of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, and the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 20, Township 10 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian.

NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey is to segregate an existing home site for conveyance. As Parcel 1 is the entire contiguous Wallowa-Whitman National Forest, only Section 20 containing Parcel 2 was platted.

The portion of Parcel 1 shown on this plat was originally acquired and withdrawn by the Bureau of Reclamation during the construction of Mason Dam and the creation of Phillips Reservoir. The lands were then transferred to the Secretary of Agriculture pursuant to the Federal Water Project Recreation Act of July 9, 1965 (79 Stat. 213) and became National Forest lands with Weeks Law status.

There is no recorded right-of-way deed for Hudspeth Road, County 667 (1010), but Baker County claims a 60' right-of-way. The Forest Service will convey Parcel 2 to the extent of Federal ownership, as we understand it, which is to the edge of the 60' right-of-way.

The location of the roads, fences, and driveways was obtained by resource grade GPS, except for Hudspeth Road and the fences in the immediate vicinity of Parcel 2, which were located by a Sokkia Set 3B electronic total station.

Know all persons by these presents that I, Steven A. Ellis, Forest Supervisor of the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest, Department of Agriculture, representing the United States of America owner in fee simple of the land as described in the Surveyor's Certificate herewith, have caused the same to be partitioned into Parcels 1 and 2.
