
HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

THE ORIGINAL SURVEY OF GUIDE MERIDIAN BETWEEN RANGES 39 AND 40 WAS DONE BY TIMOTHY W. DAVENPORT UNDER GENERAL LAND OFFICE CONTRACT NO. 102, DATED JULY 20, 20, 1863.

THE SUBDIVISION OF T10S, R40E, W.M. WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED BY THOMPSON AND CHAPLIN UNDER GENERAL LAND OFFICE CONTRACT, APPROVED AUGUST 24, 1864.

SECTIONS 29, 30 AND 31 WERE SUBDIVIDED BY CHARLES M. FOSTER UNDER GENERAL LAND OFFICE SPECIAL CONTRACT DATED FEBRUARY 16, 1889.

IN 1915 BAKER COUNTY SURVEYOR IRA HOFFMAN SET A $6" \times 14" \times 21"$ STONE MARKED "1/4" ON EAST FACE.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

FOUND 6" x 14" x 21" STONE MARKED "1/4" ON EAST FACE, SET BY BAKER COUNTY SURVEYOR IRA HOFFMAN IN 1915, PLANTED FIRMLY IN THE GROUND 1.0 FEET NORTH OF NORTHEAST FENCE CORNER IN MOUND OF STONE.
