

SURVEY NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey for Merlyn McGarry is for preparation of description of an existing fence line which will become the line separating two parcels of a proposed partition of approximately 765 acres of land described in Deed 78-07-014. A solar obseration from a point near the most northerly point along the dividing fence line is basis of bearings. Lines were calculated by inversing between radial ties to fence corners and the one-found section corner shown hereon. There are no surveys of record in this locale, excepting the original township subdivision of 1874, contract no. 211, by Benjamin F. Vaughan. County road right of way was measured 30 feet from centerline of existing roadway, due to lack of recorded road data. Monumentation was established at each end of the described fence line on road right of way.
