Northwest corner section 18,
T. 10 S., R. 44 E., of the W.M.

History of original corner

Original corner set by N. Walden
Deputy Surveyor under contract
No. 198, dated July 15, 1873
Set basalt stone 22"x10"x10".

Subsequent survey:

W.B. Barr survey under contract no. 388
Dated May 7, 1881 found stone 22" x 10" x 10".

Description of evidence found:

Found stone 22" x 10" x 10" with 4 notches on the south face and 2 notches on the north face in small mound of stone under a sagebrush 2 feet west of a cattle trail.

Description of monument and accessories

established to perpetuate the location of this corner:

Set a 5/8" diameter x 30" long iron rod and 2" Diameter aluminum cap marked:

T10S R44E
T10S R43E 12 | 7
13 | 18
LS1015
2001

From the corner point:

A 5/8" diameter x 30" long iron rod with a 1.3" diameter yellow plastic cap marked "LS1015" bears North 31° West 12.87 feet.

A 5/8" diameter x 30" long iron rod with a 1.3" diameter yellow plastic cap marked "LS1015" bears North 47° East 13.57 feet.

A 5/8" diameter x 30" long iron rod with a 1.3" diameter yellow plastic cap marked "LS1015" bears South 58° East 10.27 feet.

A 5/8" diameter x 30" long iron rod with a 1.3" diameter yellow plastic cap marked "LS1015" bears South 45° West 15.50 feet.

Deposited stone alongside new monument.
Compass declination 19° East.
