History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by H.E. Merryman, in 1913 while performing a Forest Boundary Survey for the U.S. Forest Service. The Notes from that Survey State: For corner B, Sec.3, 19.89 chs. from the center of the section and from the E.1/4 corner, I set a basalt stone  $27 \times 7 \times 3$  inches, 12 inches in earth and stone, marked 1/16 B on W. face and FS on S. face, whence

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found 27"x7"x3" stone with 1/16 B on West face & FS on South face, set vertical and solid in the ground as established by Merryman in 1913.

Found the  $8'\times8'\times5'$  stone at approx. measurement as shown in Merrymans notes. Accepted the above described stone as the C-E 1/16 corner as properly established by Merryman.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2-1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with 3-1/2" aluminum cap, stamped as shown on the **DIAGRAM**, SET 10" in the ground, set original stone North alongside pipe and raised a mound of stone around the pipe. From Which:

A Ponderosa Pine 10" dia.,Bears S55°20'W.,23.5 ft., scribed: CE 1/16 S3 BT A Ponderosa Pine 8" dia.,Bears S 6°37'E.,29.6 ft., scribed: CE 1/16 S3 BT Measurements to trees taken with an Electronic Tacheometer with Bearings turned from the survey control network.

Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe, Bearing

Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe, Bearing Tree Sign above blaze, and warning sign on back of each tree. Painted a 6" red band at breast ht. around each tree. Set steel fence posts with warning & Boundary Signs, North and East 3 ft. from the corner.
