Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set $2-1/2"\times30"$ aluminum pipe with 3-1/2" aluminum cap, stamped as shown on the **DIAGRAM**, SET 18" in the ground, set the original stone North alongside pipe and raised a mound of stone around the pipe. From Which:

A Ponderosa Pine 8" dia., Bears N38^o38'W., 9.8 ft., scribed: C1/4 S2 BT A Ponderosa Pine 10" dia., Bears N53^o02'E.,34.1 ft., scribed: C1/4 S2 BT Measurements to trees taken with an Electronic Tacheometer with Bearings turned from the survey control network.

Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe, Bearing Tree Sign above blaze, and warning sign on back of each tree. Painted a 6" red band at breast ht. around each tree. Set steel fence post with warning Sign, North 4 ft. from the corner.
