Description of corner evidence found:

FS on West face, as established by Merryman in 1913 while performing a Forest Boundary Survey for the U.S. Forest Service. Found an 18" Ponderosa Pine, with blaze healed over Bears N30 $^{\rm C}$ E., 33.4 ft. from the stone. (Record from Merryman's Notes N27 $^{\rm C}$ E., 33.7 ft.) Accepted the stone as properly established by Merryman at a point which is N 0 $^{\rm C}$ 37'42"E., 16.27 ft. from the Township Line. (Projection of Center of Section Line) Monumented the position of the above described stone as shown below.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set $2-1/2"\times30"$ aluminum pipe with 3-1/2" aluminum cap, stamped as shown on the **DIAGRAM**, SET 12" in the ground, Set the original stone North alongside pipe and raised a mound of stone around the pipe. From Which:

A Ponderosa Pine 8" dia., Bears S 9014'W.,21.8 ft., scribed: 1/400 S2 BT A Ponderosa Pine 10" dia., Bears S49055'E.,26.4 ft., scribed: 1/400 S2 BT Measurements to trees taken with an Electronic Tacheometer with Bearings turned from the survey control network.

Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe, Bearing

Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe, Bearing Tree Sign above blaze, and warning sign on back of each tree. Painted a 6" red band at breast ht. around each tree.

Used the same Bearing Trees as taken for True 1/4 Closing Corner.
