
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Eugene P. McCormack under GLO contract No. 398 dated July 2. 1881.

Surveyor's General record states:

Set a basalt stone 14x12x10 ins 10 ins in the ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on W face from which:



A pine, 18 ins diam bears S 30° E, 48 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT A pine, 24 ins diam bears N 45° W, 60 lks dist marked 1/4 S BT

Description of monument and accessories l'established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:


Set a $2\frac{1}{8}$ inch brass cap on a 2 inch iron pipe, 31 inches long, 25 inches in the ground with a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-4 attached from which:

A pine, 24 ins diam bears N $36^{\circ}30^{\circ}$ W, 165.5 ft dist marked 1/4 S 25 BT with a sign 54-3 attached 6 inches below a band of red paint and a brass washer marked LS 1206 nailed flush with BT blaze.

LS 1206 nailed flush with BT blaze.

There being no other trees available I set a 2 inch brass cap on a 2 inch iron pipe, 31 inches long, 22 inches in the ground which bears N 01°42°45" E, 48.73 ft dist marked thus:
