Orig. NW BT is gone.

BLM 9" White Fir now 12" D-Fir N34E--10.5'(record  $17\frac{1}{2}$  1ks.) Healed blaze. BLM SW BT down and out of position.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Chiseled BXO on SW face 3'x2'x2' high rock outcrop N58 $\frac{1}{4}$ E--41.5'. Chiseled BXO on top 2'x2' exposed bedrock N26 $\frac{1}{2}$ W--43.9'. Nailed 54-9 and 54-3 signs to BT's, painted bands, blazes and chisel marks red. Set guard post North with 54-9 sign.

Bearings are true by instrument tie.
