No original evidence of the corner or the bearing trees found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate position, set a 3 1/4" diam. U.S.F.S. aluminum capped pipe, 30" long, with a magnet, 20" in the ground, with a mound of stone and earth to cap, from which:

A pine, 9" in diam., bears N.37°E., 88.1 ft., double blazed and scribed "¼S7BT" with a brass washer "RLS 1060" nailed to the face of the blaze between the B and T.

A pine, 14" in diam., bears S.80°E., 32.3 ft., double blazed and scribed "¼S7BT" with a brass washer "RLS 1060"nailed to the face of the blaze between the B and T.

A pine, 26" in diam., bears S.9"W., 101.9 ft., double blazed and scribed "¼S12BT" with a brass washer "RLS 1060" nailed to the face of the blaze between the B and T.

A pine, 15" in diam., bears N.46½°W., 30.2 ft., double blazed and scribed "¼S12BT" with a brass washer "RLS 1060" nailed to the face of the blaze between the B and T.

Placed Forest Service signs (54-2,54-9) on trees and paint scars, blazes and a 6" red band around BT's. Placed two steel fence posts three to five feet from corner near property line with Forest Service signs (54-2).
