
# MAP OF SURVEY

Sections 29 and 30 T.11S. R.39E. W.M. Baker County, Oregon June, 2000



#### NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of the Wallowa-Whitman Forest Supervisor. The purpose of this survey was to delineate federal lands from private lands. The lines were established between BLM brass caps using a Leica 1610 TC total station. The data was collected using a Husky FS2 data collector loaded with C&G Software. The data was reduced on an IBM PC using C&G Software. The survey was closed loop between found monuments. The South 1/16 between 29 and 30 was set at mid-point. Bearings to references were established using a Warren Knight staff compass and distance to BT measured to a 50 penny nail, driven in the root crown, with a steel chain. Closure for the survey was 1:28,000.
