

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, stamped as shown on the diagram, 6" above ground, with 3 ft. diam. stone mound to top.

From which I find Hanley bearing trees:

A fir cut stump, bears N. 65°E., 15.8 ft. dist., with no visible marks.

A fir snag, bears N. 42° W., 31.2 ft. dist., with visible scribe on open blaze.

A pine, 9 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. 85° W., 67.0 ft. dist., with visible scribe on open blaze.

A fir cut stump, bears, N. 31° W., 90.2 ft. dist., with no visible marks.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

Established new bearing trees:

A ponderosa pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 8½° E., 92.0 ft. dist., scribed C1/4 S14 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. $27\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 28.8 ft. dist., scribed X BT.

Also set bearing object:

A pink magnet bears, S. 52° E., 11.5 ft. dist., buried 1 ft. deep in earth.


