

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:


At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

- A 7 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 34° East, a distance of 45.20 feet, marked CE 1/16 S16 BT.
- A 9 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 11° East, a distance of 53.80 feet, marked CE 1/16 S16 BT.
- I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot East of the monument.
- I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on November 23, 2013.
