

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

A 19 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 42° East, a distance of 78.65 feet, marked E 1/16 S16 BT.

A 10 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 59° East, a distance ϕ f 25.45 feet, marked E 1/16 S21 BT.


I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot East of the monument.
