

At position by survey, I set a 5/8" iron pin, 28" in the ground with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, in a 1' diam. collar of stone,

A 5" Ponderosa Pine bears North 75° East, a dist. of 32.45 ft, marked SE 1/16 S21 BT A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears North 20° West, a dist. of 33.40 ft, marked SE 1/16 S21 BT

Set steel fencepost 1 ft. North

Monument falls on steep SE aspect
