Set a basalt stone 16x16x8 ins., 10 ins. deep for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. side. from which

A pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 80° W., 353 lks. dist., mkd. % S BT.

A pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 1° E. 380 lks. dist., mkd. ${\mathcal U}_{\!\! 4}$ S BT.

Subsequent Monumentation:

Corner found and maintained by D. T. Callahan, PE 4078, for Crown Zellerbach Corp., recorded in 1973 as Baker County Survey No. 11-40-32.

At the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. to secs. 8 and 17, found the original 16x16x8 ins. stone with $\frac{1}{4}$ mark on the north face in place.

from which

A 30 ins. diam. rotted stump bears N. 1° E. , 380 lks., with visible scribe on open blaze. A rotted stump bears N. 80° W., 353 lks., with no visible scribe marks.

In order to preserve this corner location, four rocks larger than the monument stone were piled on the south side of said corner stone and two new bearing trees

A ponderosa pine, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 7° W., 14.2 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S BT.

A ponderosa pine, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 41° W., 35.1 ft. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

Corner remonumented BLM cadastral surveyor, A. Joseph Garrison, under special instructions dated May 3, 1957, and approved June 13, 1977. record states

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 17, monumented with a basalt stone, 18x12x6 ins., (record, 16x16x8 ins.) firmly set 10 ins. in the ground, and in a small mound of stone, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which the remains of the original bearing trees

A sawed and decayed pine stump, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 2½° E., 386 lks. dist, with scribe mark S visible on partialy healed blaze. (record N. 1° E. , 380 lks.)

and bearing trees mkd. by Crown Zellerbach Timber Co.

A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $40\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 56.5 lks. dist., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT visible on partialy healed blaze.

A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 6%° W., 22 lks. dist., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT visible on partialy healed blaze.



Set an iron post 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in ground, in a small mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as shown.

from which new bearing trees

A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 28½° E., 55 lks. dist., mkd. ½ S8 BT.

A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $17\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 22 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S17 BT. Deposit corner stone alongside iron post.



Found a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28" galvanized iron pipe with standard BLM 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " brass cap, firmly set in concrete alongside fence corner post, projecting 8 ins. above ground, stamped as shown on the diagram.

from which bearing trees mkd. by Crown Zellerbach Timber Co.

A pine, 16 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 40% W., 35.2 ft. dist., with healed blaze. (record S. 40½° W., 56.5 lks.)

A pine, 19 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. $6\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 22 lks. dist., with healed blaze. and BLM bearing trees

A pine, 21 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. 28%° E., 55 lks. dist., with healed blaze. A pine, 14 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 17%° E., 22 lks. dist., with healed blaze.
