Set 1/2" x 24" iron pins with aluminum caps as follows:

S13-07'E, 168.31 ft., stamped NW S19, RM with an arrow and course to the corner. This pin is part of the survey control network. Set a steel post with warning sign along side this pin.

Set steel posts with warning sign 3' West.
