In 1960, C. Albert White, Cadastral Surveyor for The Bureau Of Land Managment, under special instructions, group No. 261, dated Sep. 3, 1940, approved Jan. 16, 1941, and assignment instructions dated May 5, 1960, re-monumented this corner at proportionate distance.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2-1/2" iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM. Corner monument is solid and in good condition. Found bearing tree as established by C. Albert White Pine 36 ins. dia. bears N42E, 42.9 ft., healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:
Set 1/2" x 24" iron pins with aluminum caps as follows:
N45-24'W, 13.5 ft., stamped 1/4 S18, RM with an arrow and course to the corner.
S46-45'E, 17.0 ft., stamped 1/4 S19, RM with an arrow and course to the corner.
South, 10.2 ft., stamped 1/4 S19, RM with an arrow and course to the corner. Measurements to pin taken with compass in both directions.
Declination 19 1/2 deg. East.
Set steel post with warning sign 3' North.
