

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

In 1960, C. Albert White, Cadastral Surveyor for The Bureau Of Land Management, under special instructions, group No. 261, dated Sep. 3, 1940, approved Jan. 16, 1941, and assignment instructions dated May 5, 1960, set 2-1/2" iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM from which:

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2-1/2" iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM. Corner monument is solid and in good condition. All previously established accessories have been rendered useless in the long term by the 1989 fire. Refer to the above referenced notes.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 1/2" x 24" iron pins with aluminum caps as follows:
S48-33'E, 12.2 ft., stamped N1/16, S19, RM with an arrow and course to the corner.
N33-53'E, 10.5 ft., stamped N1/16, S19, RM with an arrow and course to the corner.
Measurements to pin taken with electronic tachimeter with angles turned from the survey control network.
