A W. Fir 12" diam. bears S85 39'W., 12.7, scribed C1/4 S19 BT
A W. Fir 10" diam. bears N21 22'W., 26.9, scribed C1/4 S19 BT
A P.Pine 8" diam. bears N69 33'E., 10.6, scribed C1/4 S19 BT
Set 1/2"x24" iron pins with aluminum caps, as follows:
S06 29'E., 50.73 ft., stamped C1/4 S19 RM and arrow with course to the corner and 1989, PLS 848. This Pin is part of the survey control network. Set a steel post with warning sign alongside this pin.

Measurements to accessories taken with electronic tachimeter with angles turned from the survey control network. Set steel fence posts with Warning and Boundary signs 2 ft. East & 4 ft. West from the monument.
