Found 2-1/2" iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM. Corner monument is solid and in good condition. Found bearing tree as established by C. Albert White Fir 15 ins. diam. bears N83E, 5.4 ft., healed blaze. Fir 12 ins. diam. bears N69W, 36.3 ft., healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:
W. Fir 12" Diam. bears S36E, 25.1 ft., scribed 1/4 S20 BT.
Set 1/2" x 24" iron pins with aluminum caps as follows:
S82-50'W, 216.85 ft., stamped 1/4 S19, RM with an arrow and course to the corner. This pin is part of the survey control network. Set a steel post with warning sign along side this pin.
Measurements to pin taken with electronic tachiometer with angles turned from the survey control network.
Set steel post with warning sign 4' West.
