

**RECORD PROPERTY DESCRIPTION**

All that portion of the following described parcel lying South and West of the U.S. 30 Highway right of way.

Beginning at a point on the West right of way line of the Old Oregon Trail Highway, being S 78°55' W, 257 feet from the Northeast corner of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 11 S., R. 43 E., W. 1/4, thence S. 41°41' W, 171.6 feet, thence N. 49°30' W, 123 feet, thence N. 41°55' E, 171.6 feet to a granite monument; thence S. 49°32' E, along the West highway right of way line 123 feet to the point of beginning.

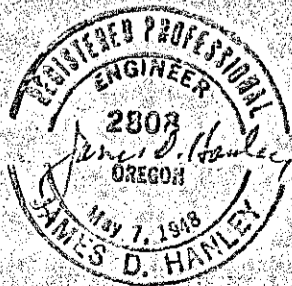
- The NE corner of SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 29 is not established.
- The East 1/2 cor. of Sec. 29 falls in county road, not found.
- Granite monument shown is 5.5 ft. on hwy. right of way & NE tract corner is 9.9 ft. on hwy. right of way.
- Closing course dist. of description is 122.3 feet.
