NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF JIMMY SULLIVAN, WITH THE PURPOSE OF SURVEYING THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF THAT CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN DEED NO. B19 08 0082, AND ALSO TO SURVEY THAT PORTION OF THE SULLIVAN'S EXISTING DRIVEWAY SITUATED OVER AND ACROSS VACATED FOURTH STREET IN JOHN S. LIVINGSTON'S TOWNSITE OF DURKEE.

JOHN S. LIVINGSTON'S TOWNSITE OF DURKEE WAS RECORDED MAY 11, 1908 IN BOOK 66 PAGE 560, DEED RECORDS OF BAKER COUNTY, OREGON. PORTIONS OF STREETS AND ALLEYS WITHIN THE ADDITION WERE VACATED BY ORDER OF THE BAKER COUNTY COURT, DATED JANUARY 6, 1943, RECORDED IN COMMISSIONER'S JOURNAL "K", PAGES 143–145. SAID ORDER WAS SUBSEQUENTLY RECORDED IN THE DEED RECORDS ON AUGUST 16, 1989, AS DEED NO. 89 33 126. SEARCHING THE AVAILABLE COUNTY SURVEY RECORDS, I FOUND THE FOLLOWING RELEVANT SURVEYS: 11–43–3, 11–43–7, 11–43–10, 11–43–17A, 11–43–18 AND 11–43–20. I ALSO FOUND OREGON STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT DRAWING NO. 8B–29–1, WHICH WAS UTILIZED FOR THE LOCATION OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF VANDECAR ROAD.

I MADE FIELD MEASUREMENTS TO LOCATE APPURTENANT CONTROLLING MONUMENTS SHOWN ON THE AFOREMENTIONED SURVEYS. I FOUND THE 1/2" IRON PINS SET IN SURVEY NO. 11-43-3 ON THE NORTH LINE OF BLOCK 3 BADLY BENT, POSSIBLY DUE TO CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY IN THE AREA. I DID NOT UTILIZE THESE PINS FOR THIS SURVEY. ALL OTHER MONUMENTS WERE FOUND IN GOOD CONDITION AND ACCEPTED.

THE RIGHT OF WAY OF VANDECAR ROAD WAS DETERMINED BY HOLDING THE FOUND O.D.O.T. MONUMENT AT THE P.I. OF THE CURVE, AND ROTATING THE RECORD BEARINGS FROM O.S.H.D. DRAWING NO. 8B-29-1 CLOCKWISE 02'07'40" TO CONFORM TO THE BASIS OF BEARINGS OF THIS SURVEY. I HELD THE FOUND 1/2" IRON PIN AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF BLOCK 3 AND RAN A LINE PARALLEL WITH THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 28 FOR THE WEST LINE OF DURKEE STREET.

A NEW MONUMENT WAS SET AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SULLIVAN PROPERTY ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND. AT MR. SULLIVAN'S REQUEST, I ALSO LOCATED THE EDGES OF THE EXISTING DRIVEWAY FOR LEGAL DESCRIPTION PURPOSES.


