
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Herman D Gradon under GLO contract no. 428 and dated Dec. 16, 1881.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a basalt stone 20 x 12 x 5 ins 15 ins in the ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on west face, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins north and south of stone $5\frac{1}{2}$ feet distance and raised mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ feet high and $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet base alongside.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 21 \times 11 \times 6 inches firmly set 12 inches in the ground and marked 1/4 on the east side in an old fence corner from which the fence bears north, south and east.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch brass cap on a 1 inch iron pipe 31 inches long and projecting 6 inches out of the ground with a surrounding rock mound. Buried original stone 1 foot east.
