


QUARTER CORNER BETWEEN
SECTIONS 5 & 6 TOWNSHIP 11 NORTH, RANGE 15 WEST T.1., Oregon

From the corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8 I run Northerly along a random line and find the corner common to Sections 5 and 6 on the North body of the township 1559.67 feet distant. I determine the true bearing of the line to be North two degrees nine minutes West ($N 02^{\circ}09' W$). From said corner on the North body of the township I run South two degrees nine minutes West ($S 02^{\circ}09' W$) a distance of two thousand eight hundred & sixty-nine and thirty hundredths (2869.30) feet and make diligent search over wide area. The corner between Sections 5 and 6 has been destroyed. I locate same according to proportionate distances. I continue South two degrees nine minutes West ($S 02^{\circ}09' W$) a distance of two thousand six hundred ninety and thirty-seven hundredths (2690.37) feet to the corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8.
