

RUNNING EAST BETWEEN SECTIONS
5 & 8, T. 11 S., R. 46 E. W.M., Ore.

From the corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, T. 11 S., R. 46 E. W.M. I run N. $89^{\circ}11'$ E. (record angle) 2640 feet and make diligent search and fail to find $\frac{1}{2}$ corner between Sections 5 and 8. I continue N. $89^{\circ}11'$ E. to the left bank of the Snake River and make diligent search and fail to find meander corner between Sections 5 and 8. I return to point for $\frac{1}{2}$ corner and set a stone, basalt stone $2\frac{1}{4}" \times 10" \times 6"$, 8" in the ground marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on North face, raised mound of stone along side and painted same yellow, set $3/4" \times 10"$ pipe with red flag on corner.
