

RUNNING EAST BETWEEN SECTIONS  
5 & 8, T. 11 S., R. 46 E. W.M., Ore.

From the corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, T. 11 S., R. 46 E. W.M. I run N. 89°11' E. (record angle) 2640 feet and make diligent search and fail to find  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between Sections 5 and 8. I continue N. 89°11' E. to the left bank of the Snake River and make diligent search and fail to find meander corner between Sections 5 and 8. I return to point for  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner and set a stone, basalt stone 24" x 10" x 6", 8" in the ground marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on North face, raised mound of stone along side and painted same yellow, set 3/4" x 10' pipe with red flag on corner.
