
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry W.Cooke under Contract No. 427 and dated December 15, 1881.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a basalt stone 16 x 12 x 10 ins 11 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on West face and raised a mound of stone alongside.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone 17 x 12 x $8"(record, 16 \times 12 \times 10")$ with faint marks possibly "4S" in scattered mound at fence corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found original stone...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 18" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried original stone alongside.

New bearing trees established:

A p pine 18" dia bears N19 $\frac{1}{4}$ 0W, 120.2' marked 1/4S23 BT. A p pine 21" dia bears N54 $\frac{1}{2}$ 0E, 145.7' marked 1/4S24 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3~&~54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each BT. Set steel fence post South of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Compass declination 19° East.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly re-established to U.S.F.S. standards under my supervision and witnessed by Scott Munro on May 21, 1987.
