## Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone 16 x 12 x 10"(record 12 x 10 x 10") firmly set marked 1/4 on N face, stone broken in half from which:

A p pine 17" dia bears  $S81_4^{\circ}W(\text{record }S80^{\circ}W)$ , 7.1' with healed blaze. A fir 19" dia bears  $N50^{\circ}E(\text{record }N65^{\circ}E)$ , 40.0', with visible scribing.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found stone...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 8" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried corner stone alongside.

Attached to each original BT, signs 54-3 and 54-9 and painted blaze and 6" red band around each. Set steel fence post West of corner with sign 54-9.

Compass declination 19° East.
