
## History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry W.Cooke under Contract No. 427 and dated December 15, 1881.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a basalt stone  $16 \times 12 \times 8$  ins 11 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on W face from which:

A pine 30" dia bears  $S80^{\circ}W$ , 133 lks dist marked 1/4S BT A pine 15" dia bears  $N40^{\circ}E$ , 74 lks dist marked 1/4S BT.



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone 13 x 11 x 10"(record, 16 x 12 x 8") with "4" visible in a stone mound from which:

A p pine 36" dia bears  ${\rm N40}^{\rm o}{\rm E}$ , 47.9' with scribing visible on charred blaze.

A p pine snag 28" dia bears  $\rm S80^{\circ}W$ , 87.8' with scribing visible on charred blaze.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found original stone...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 13" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried original stone alongside.

New bearing tree established: A p pine 12" dia bears N80½°W, 56.7' marked 1/4S27 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each BT. Set steel fence post East of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Compass declination 190 East.
