
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry W.Cooke under Contract No. 427 and dated December 15, 1881.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a basalt stone  $18 \times 14 \times 10$  ins 12 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on W face, dug pits  $18 \times 10^{-2}$ 18 x 12 ins N & S of cor 5½ ft dist and raised a mound of earth 2 ft high 4 ft base alongside.



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found basalt stone 20 x 12 x 7(record states 18 x 14 x 10") with chisel marks which are illegible.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found stone....

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried corner stone alongside.

New bearing trees established: A p pine 13" dia bears S46½°W, 39.9' marked 1/4S26 BT. A juniper 8" dia bears S76°E, 44.1' marked 1/4S25 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band around each BT. Set steel fence post West of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Compass declination 19° East.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly re-established to U.S.F.S. standards under my supervision and witnessed by Scott Munro on May 15, 1987.
