
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Henry W.Cooke under Contract No. 427 and dated December 15, 1881.

Surveyor General records state:

Set a basalt stone 14 x 14 x 7 ins 10 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on W face and raised a mound of stone alongside.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 14 x 11 x 7"(record 14 x 14 x 7") with "4" on W face, with a 2' diameter mound of stone on W side.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found original stone...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried corner stone alongside.

New bearing trees established: The North stem of a double juniper 9" dia bears $S21\frac{1}{2}^{O}E$, 53.7' marked 1/4S36 BT. A 15" p pine bears $S34\frac{1}{2}^{O}W$, 114.1' marked 1/4S35 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band around each BT. Set steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Compass declination 19° East.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly re-established to U.S.F.S. standards under my supervision and witnessed by Bill Blanford on May 14, 1987.
