Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground, surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram. Buried original stone alongside.

New bearing trees established: A 11" p pine bears N63 $^{\rm O}$ W, 15.0' scribed 1/4S26 BT. A 10" p pine bears S30 $^{\rm O}$ W, 53.2' scribed 1/4S35 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3~&~54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each BT. Set steel fence post East of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Compass declination 190 East.
