A pine 24 ins diam bears S42°E, 170 1ks dist marked Tl2SR37ES19 BT. No other trees within limits, raised a mound of stone alongside.

Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence found after $3\frac{1}{2}$ hours searching with 2 person crew on 3 seperate occasions. The corner area and bearing tree area has been disturbed by spring development, ditch construction and pasture development.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Re-established corner by single proportion measurement between found 1/4 13 18 and $\frac{24}{25}$ $\frac{19}{30}$...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 32" in the ground. Cap marked as shown in

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" band of red around each BT. Set steel fence post 5.0' South of corner and attached sign 54-9. Reference monuments have a steel fence post next to them and signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached.
